RATE SCHEDULE A-1
Single Phase Service
Effective September 1, 2010

AVAILABILITY

Available for all uses, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Seller, for:

- Farm and Rural Residential Consumers
- Town-Residential Consumers
- Public Buildings (Schools, Churches, Community Halls)
- Commercial and Small Industrial

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage. The capacity of individual motors served under this schedule shall not exceed 10 H.P. except by special permission. This permission may be granted when voltage drop studies indicate a minimal voltage drop to other consumers.

RATE

Base Rate:

- Farm & Rural Residential is \$24.00 per month plus \$.54 per KVA over 25KVA of installed transformer capacity
- Town Residential is \$20.00 per month
- Public Buildings are \$20.00 per month
- Commercial and Small Industrial is \$28.00 per month

KWH Rate:

- Farm & Rural Residential is \$.085 per KWH per month
- Town-Residential is \$.090 per KWH per month
- Public Buildings is \$.098 per KWH per month
- Commercial and Small Industrial is \$.074 per KWH per month

MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the base rate or greater if established rules and line extension policies apply.

For farm & rural residential consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of \$.54 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. The cooperative will retain the right to determine the transformer capacity to be installed.

Where more than 1200 feet of new overhead line extension is required, the member will be responsible for 40% of the total cost of construction based on current rates. The member portion of construction cost (if applicable) must be paid in advance before construction begins unless other arrangements have been made with the cooperative.

COST OF PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT

If at any time after September 1, 2010, the wholesale cost of purchased power is increased or decreased, the seller may increase or decrease the selling cost .1 mills for every .1 mill, or major fraction thereof, the cost of purchased power is increased or decreased. The purchased power adjustment shall be shown as a separate item on the consumer's billing statement.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Meters are read by the cooperative on the first of the month and current bill shall be paid by the first of the following month to avoid penalties.
