RATE SCHEDULE A-3 (LOW TEMPERATURE GRAIN DRYING)

Single Phase Service
Effective September 1, 2010

AVAILABILITY

Available by special permission for low temperature grain drying, aeration and equipment used at a location other than a residence. The transformer capacity required shall not exceed 25 KVA except by special permission.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

RATE

Base Rate:

- Base Rate @ \$28.00 per month plus \$.54 per KVA over 25 KVA of installed transformer capacity

KWH Rate:

- All KWH @ \$.074 per month

MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$28.00 where the required new line extension does not exceed 1200 feet.

For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of \$.54 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. The cooperative will retain the right to determine the transformer capacity to be installed.

Where more than 1200 feet of new overhead line extension is required, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased \$.54 for each additional 100 feet or fraction thereof.

The minimum will be considered a contract minimum. The consumer shall enter into a five (5) year contract with the above provisions applying.

The contract for the first five years shall be executed between the consumer and Burke-Divide Electric Cooperative before construction begins.

If the member wishes to terminate service during the first five year period, the unused portion of the 5 year contract will be paid in full.

The Cooperative will retain the right to determine the transformer capacity to be installed.

COST OF PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT

If at any time after September 1, 2010, the wholesale cost of purchased power is increased or decreased, the seller may increase or decrease the selling cost .1 mills for every .1 mill, or major fraction thereof, the cost of purchased power is increased or decreased. The purchased power adjustment shall be shown as a separate item on the consumer's billing statement.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Meters are read by the cooperative on the first of the month and current bill shall be paid by the first of the following month to avoid penalties.
