RATE SCHEDULE B-3
Large Power Service and Oil Well Pumping
Effective September 1, 2010

AVAILABILITY

Available to consumers located on or near seller's multi-phase lines for continuous type of usage, with loads of 15 horsepower or larger, subject to the established rules and regulations of seller.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Multi-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower must be three-phase.

RATE

Base Rate:

- Large Power Service and Oil Wells < 50 KVA @ \$200.00 per month
- Large Power Service and Oil Wells > 50 KVA @ \$350.00 per month

KWH Rate:

- Energy Charge for all services is \$.054 per KWH per month
- Demand Charge for all services is \$12.50 per kilowatt of demand

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the base rate or greater if established rules and line extension policies apply. The minimum monthly charge will be the applicable base rate for the type of service listed above.

COST OF PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT

If at any time after September 1, 2010, the wholesale cost of purchased power is increased or decreased, the seller may increase or decrease the selling cost .1 mills for every .1 mill, or major fraction thereof, the cost of purchased power is increased or decreased. The purchased power adjustment shall be shown as a separate item on the consumer's billing statement.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Meters are read by the cooperative on the first of the month and current bill shall be paid by the 10th of the following month to avoid penalties.
